### Film

**King of Peking, Australia, 2017, M, Comedy/Drama, 88 mins. Subtitled.**

Director: Sam Voutas.

Officially selected for Tribeca, Melbourne, London, Stockholm & Golden Horse Film Festivals.

With the same infectious spirit as 'Cinema Paradiso', this comedy is an inventive and light exploration of a father's love for both his son and the movies.

Big Wong (Zhao Jun) is a single parent to his son, Little Wong (Wang Naixun), and they have a ramshackle business screening American movies in their village in China in the 1990's. This is where most of the comedy originates.

Includes many references to films that most film buffs would recognise. But the film is more than that – It explores the family dynamics, including the relationship between the son and his unconventional father, with some sweet and more serious moments.

Scores 6.5 on IMDb. Won 7 Awards from 10 nominations.
